Through her career, Kimberley moved up the ranks, serving her community with distinction and making important contributions to policing at every level. In 2013, she was named Chief of the Barrie Police Service. After high school, Greenwood joined the Toronto Police Service as a cadet. As a relatively young police officer, Greenwood became involved in developing policy and implementing a training program to support a multidisciplinary approach to child abuse investigations. This approach has become the standard practice in most police forces. She also helped implement the Leaders in Partnership program, working with the local school boards and the Jamaican Canadian Association to identify at-risk youth in the Jane and Finch community of Toronto, and arranging for them to be mentored by police officers.
