ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Internationally trained professionals who:

- Are residents of Ontario
- Permanent Residents, Naturalized Canadian
 Citizens, Refugee Claimants, Convention Refugees,
 Approved Provincial nominee under the Ontario
 Immigrant Nominee Program, Visitors under
 Emergency Travel measures enacted by the federal
 government (e.g., CUAET), and residents with
 temporary work permits who have received
 permanent residency approval in principle from
 IRCC.
- Have educational qualifications outside of Canada with a minimum equivalency to a Canadian degree or diploma
- Have Previous work experience outside of Canada in Supply Chain, Logistics or Purchasing including Supply Chain related experience in Business, Project Management or Engineering.
