Admission Process

Admission to a Post-Secondary Diploma or Certificate program

1. One of the following:
 - Bachillerato de Nivel Medio o Secundario
 - Bachillerato Especializado
 - Perito Mercantil
 - Certificado de Tecnico
 - All the above must be completed with a minimum grade of 6.0 - 7.0 (bueno) in required program subjects.
2. English Proficiency requirements are as follows for consideration:
3. A minimum TOEFL score of 550 (paper based) or 80 (internet based with no single test score below 20) - TOEFL code 9285 or IELTS with an overall minimum score of 6.0 (with no single test score below 5.5) or CAEL (Canadian Academic English Language Assessment) with an overall band score of 60.

Admission to a Bachelor's Degree program

1. Bachillerato/Bachillerato Especializado with a minimum grade of 8.0 (distinguido) in required program subjects.
2. Include transcripts for any postsecondary courses or programs completed
3. English Proficiency requirements are as follows for consideration:
 - A minimum TOEFL score of 560 (paper based) or 84 (internet based with no single test score below 21) or an IELTS with an overall minimum score of 6.5 (no single test score below 6.0) or CAEL (Canadian Academic English Language Assessment) with an overall band score of 60.
 - Bachelor of Nursing Degree: a minimum TOEFL score of 600 (paper based) or 100 + (internet based with no single test score below 21) or IELTS score with an overall minimum score of 7.0 (with no single test score below 6.5)

Admission to a Graduate Certificate program

1. Bachelor's degree and University transcripts
2. English Proficiency requirements are as follows for consideration:
 - A minimum TOEFL score of 580 (paper based) or 88 (internet based with no single test score below 22) or an IELTS with an overall minimum score of 6.5 (with no single test score below 6.0) or CAEL with an overall band score of 70. - TOEFL code 9285

These are minimums cut-offs and the admissions decision is at the discretion of Humber Institute. Admissions requirements may change at any time.

Educational Requirements

Admission to a Bachelor's Degree program

To be eligible you must possess the equivalent of an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) and required courses as noted on specific program web pages at: humber.ca/program.

Admission to a Graduate Certificate program

Admission to a Graduate Certificate program

Conditional Admission through English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

Those students who would like to prepare their English skills at Humber or who do not meet Humber's minimum English cut-off may consider **English for Academic Purposes (ESL)**. EAP offers multiple start date options, and consists of 8 levels, each 8 weeks in length. For IELTS only please request an electronic copy of your scores be sent to Humber Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning attention International Centre.
