An escape room is a game in which a team of players cooperatively discovers clues, solves puzzles, and accomplishes tasks in one or more rooms in order to accomplish a specific goal in a limited time. The goal is to escape from the site of the game. In this 3-part miniseries, we will play and explore Digital Escape Rooms, then learn how to use simple tools like Google Forms, Docs and Slides to create an interactive and engaging Digital Escape Room for your students.
