Supporting faculty with the Move to Blackboard Ultra

Our workshops will help you learn all about the new, mobile-friendly, accessible version of Blackboard!

Preparing for the Move to ULTRA September 27, 9:00am—10:30am

In this session the Blackboard support team will discuss what to expect as we move to Blackboard Ultra. They will take you through the migration plan, discuss the two methods of converting your course into Ultra, introduce the tools they've created to help you, and highlight the support you can expect as we migrate to Ultra.

Getting Started with Blackboard ULTRA September 28, 12:00pm—1:30pm

Participants will learn about the new Blackboard ULTRA dashboard and course navigation. Participants will learn how to apply the Humber template and create and send announcements and course messages in an ULTRA course. Also, we will look at the main content structures and tools available.

*Using Groups in Blackboard ULTRA** September 29, 4:00pm—4:45 pm

Collaborative learning offers many benefits over traditional instruction. Studies show that when students work as a team, they develop positive attitudes, solve problems more effectively, and experience a greater sense of accomplishment. This intermediate session will show you how to use the Groups tool in Blackboard Learn Ultra to facilitate student collaboration and enhance student engagement in your course.

Creating Content in Blackboard ULTRA September 30, 2:30 am—4:00 pm

The new Blackboard ULTRA courses will give faculty and students a simpler, more modern, and accessible platform to communicate, collaborate, and learn together. In this session, we will explore the options for building content and learning materials in Blackboard ULTRA.

Everything You Need to Know about the Move to Blackboard Ultra

From May 2021 to September 2022 Humber College will be moving to Blackboard Ultra.

Why are we changing to Blackboard Ultra now?

Because students urgently need a mobile-friendly, more accessible learning management system (LMS). When the pandemic forced schools online, it exacerbated a known issue: students were struggling accessing courses on their mobile devices because our current LMS was not up to the task.

Now, more than 70% of students are accessing their courses on mobile devices. Blackboard Ultra will resolve many of these issues and serve our students better.
