Anti-Corruption Policy

Purpose/Rationale:

- 1. No person representing Humber shall attempt to corrupt a government official or any other functionary by means of giving something of value, including money in any form to obtain an improper benefit.
- 2. Bribes or kickbacks in all transactions are forbidden, regardless of whether any government officials are involved.
- Humber maintains a system of financial and accounting procedures, including internal accounting controls to ensure the maintenance of fair and accurate books, records and accounts.

ANTI-CORRUPTION
