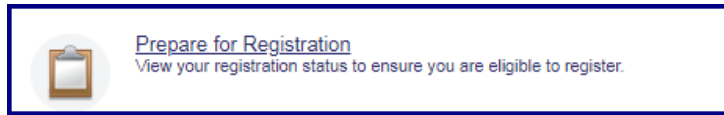


## How to Prepare for Registration


### Login

1. Login to [MyHumber](#)
2. Click **Student**
3. Click **Registration**
4. Click **Prepare for Registration**
5. Select a Term



### Registration Status

1. Confirm your ability to register for the selected term by confirming your:
  - a. **Student Status** – Active or Inactive status
  - b. **Academic Status** – Required to Withdrawn students will not be permitted to register
  - c. **Holds** – Review Process Affected to verify the hold(s) prevent registration.  
Not all holds will prevent registration. For more information on holds:



### Holds Information
