Dr. Wesley Crichlow (Ph.D., University of Toronto, 1998) is a full professor whose work intersectionally employs Critical Race Theory, Queer Theory and Anti-Black Racist Scholarly Activism as the signature framing, praxis and naming of his research teaching and service. His work aims to provide incremental measures to alleviate anti-Black racism, structural, and systemic inequalities. He teaches at Ontario Tech University (2003-present) within the youth and criminal justice discipline with over 25 years of university community mobilization and development.
