

EMPLOYEE SEXUAL VIOLENCE REPORTING AND RESOURCES

If you, or someone else, has experienced <u>sexual violence</u> or <u>sexual assault</u> on Humber College property-

Immediate Response:

- 1. Go to a safe place, including your work site, the Department of Public Safety or your home
- 2. Seek immediate support by telephone:
 - <u>Department of Public Safety</u>: 416-675-8500, or open the <u>Guardian App</u> and select "Call Humber Security."
- 3. Call Police: 911
- 4. Seek medical attention if necessary. Go to an emergency room that has a domestic violence and sexual assault care centre (if accessible) or a local hospital.
- 5. Seek help/counselling/resources see the list of on-campus and external supports below.
