By completing this form, you agree to the following:

- My new name will be used on education records, confirmation of enrolment and credentials (certificate of completion).
- Humber will retain records of all given names as part of the student information system records.
- External institutions may not recognize or accept a name change for legal purposes. These institutions include, but may not be limited to: financial institutions, RESP providers, potential employers, other educational institutions, police records check, Revenue Canada, Citizenship and Immigration and health insurance providers. It's important to understand that inconsistency between the preferred name used by Humber and the name used by external organizations may cause unexpected difficulty and it is solely your responsibility to resolve such discrepancies.
