Registration

When you have paid your tuition deposit and paid or **arranged to pay** the full balance of your tuition fees, you will be able to register when registration opens each term.

You will need to ensure you register for the minimum number of credits to meet the required course load for your OSAP funding:

- Full-time OSAP application - minimum of 60 per cent of a full semester course load (or minimum 40 per cent of a 100 per cent course load for students with a documented permanent disability).
- Part-time OSAP application - between 20 and 59 per cent of a full semester course load.
