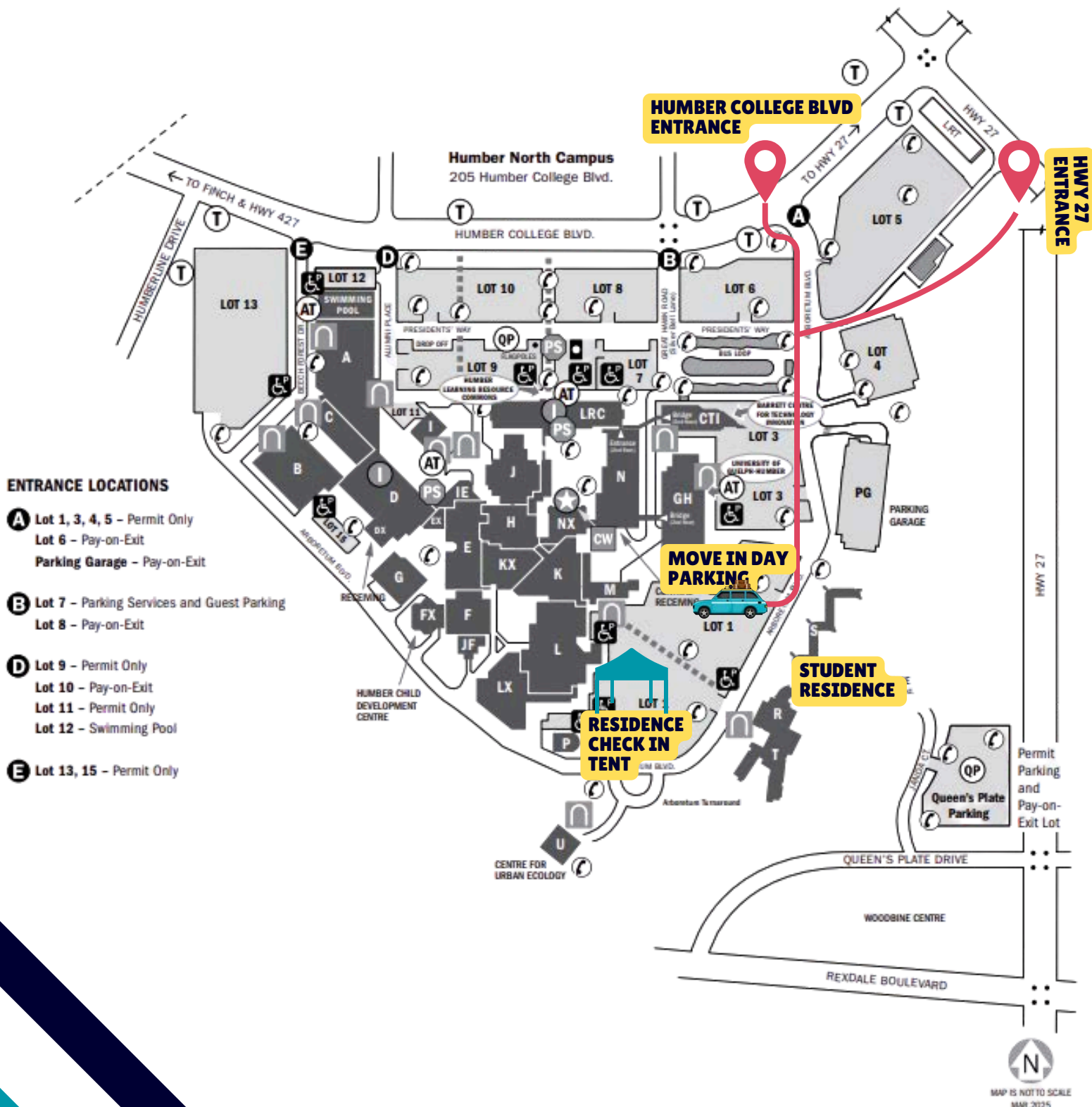

Move In Day Instructions

1. Arrive at the Residence on Move In Day during your assigned time slot:
 - o **8:30am - 11:30am:** Residents with last names from **A-K**
 - o **1:00pm- 4:00pm:** Residents with last names from **L-Z**
2. Follow the signs to the residence. Park your vehicle in Lot 1, adjacent to the Residence. **DO NOT UNLOAD YET.**
3. Leave your move in helpers in the car and walk to the Check In Tent located in Lot 1, opposite the main entrance of the Residence to check in.
4. During check in, you will receive your residence room key and be directed to your nearest entrance.
5. Return to your vehicle. Follow the directions of the staff to the unloading zone for your room location. From the unloading zone, you will move your belongings to your room.
6. After you have unloaded, return your vehicle to Lot 1.
7. Complete the unit Inventory Report within 48 hours of checking in.
8. If you have any problems with your room, report it to the Front Desk or log a work order (instructions in next section).

Moving in AFTER 4:00pm on August 24?

1. Follow the signs to Residence and park your vehicle in Lot 1.
2. Proceed to the Residence Front Desk to check in.
3. Complete the unit Inventory Report within 48 hours of checking in.
4. If you have any problems with your room, report it to the Front Desk or log a work order.



Inventory Report

Each student must complete their room Inventory Report **within 48 hours of checking in.** To complete your Inventory Report, go to the **Residence Portal**. You must indicate the condition of the items in your room on this report. Your Inventory Report is only for comparison purposes when you move out, and is not reviewed for immediate issues or repairs. At move out you will be charged for any damages, cleaning or missing items which were not indicated on your Inventory Report upon move in.

Room Repairs

To report any maintenance issues, room repair requirements, or safety issues, you **MUST** complete a work order through the Residence Portal or contact the front desk for assistance. Any urgent matters, such as water leaks, should be reported immediately to avoid damage.

Decorating Your Room

Remember that you will be held responsible for any damages to your room or suite. Do not make permanent changes, such as painting, installing tiles or permanent carpeting, putting nails in the walls or using duct tape for posters. Use painter's tape **ONLY** to hang your posters and photos, and remove gently to avoid damage to the paint in your room. We suggest using wall decals that cling to the wall without leaving adhesive residue on the wall. Residents are also not permitted to post or paint anything on exterior windows or doors. Each room has a bulletin board outside the room to post materials.

As stated in the Code of Student Community Standards, no postings will be permitted on hallway and common area walls in residence. Please keep in mind that your personal bulletin board postings must be appropriate for community living standards and the comfort level of all residents.

Important Note On Guests

From 8:00a.m. on August 24 - 8:00a.m. on September 2 (i.e. Orientation), no guests will be permitted, with the exception of friends and family members who may temporarily enter the Residence to help residents with their move. Year round, minors (17 years of age and younger) are not the Age of Majority in Ontario, and are not permitted to stay as guests in residence during the overnight period of 12:00a.m. - 7:00a.m.
