

NOTIFICATION OF FILMING

To the Staff, Students and Faculty of:

Shade PI S2 Productions Inc is looking forward to filming scenes at for the second season of "Private Eyes", on the east and west campus, on **Wednesday**, **February 8**, **2017** and **Thursday**, **February 9**, **2017**.

Beginning its second season, "Private Eyes", starring Jason Priestley, is a rousing P.I. procedural that combines drama, humour, and romance. Priestley plays "Matt 'Shadow' Shade", an ex-pro hockey player who uses his ability to read people and anticipate their moves in his new gig as a crime-solving P.I. along with his smart, beautiful, and feisty partner "Angie Everett" played by Cindy Sampson (Roque, Rookie Blue).

Filming

- Filming on both February 8 and February 9 will begin at approximately 7:30am in the City of Toronto's Colonel Samuel Smith Park, on the field just south of H Building.
- Colonel Samuel Smith Park will be used to double as military training grounds, with actors dressed in military fatigues carrying prop/replica firearms. Army vehicles will be parked along the road opposite Lot #5. No prop/replica firearms will be used on Humber College property.
- During our exterior filming on both days there will be intermittent stoppages of traffic on the east leg of Colonel Samuel Smith Park Dr with the assistance of Members of the Toronto Police Department. Additional details as follows:

On Wednesday, February 8:

- From approximately 9:00am 5:00pm we will film in the circular driveway and in front of Building G.
- During this time we will have vehicles pulling up to the entrance of Building G on camera
- Following this scene, we will move to the interior of The Assembly Hall (1 Colonel Samuel Smith Park Dr) for the duration of our evening until approximately 9:00pm.

On Thursday, February 9:

- Our first scene in Colonel Samuel Smith Park will involve shooting range training, and will involve a squib on a target to simulate a target being hit. This effect will be carried out under the supervision of the Toronto Police Department.
- At approximately 12:00pm (noon) we will then move to building A, where filming will continue in the gymnasium area as well as room A110 until approximately 9:00pm.

Parking

- Our equipment and support trucks will be parked on the east side of Twenty Third St from Lakeshore Blvd to Lake Promenade.
- Our smaller equipment trucks will start on both days parked on plywood in Colonel Samuel Smith Park, opposite the circular drive of Building G.
- On February 8 they will move to the Assembly Hall Parking for the evening, and on February 9 they will move to the West Campus loading dock on the east side of Building A and on 23rd St near Bldg A.
