

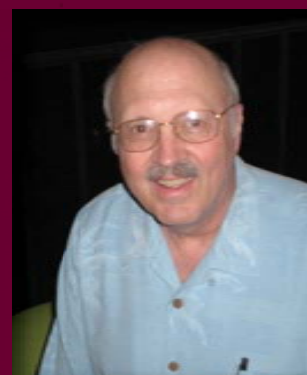

» **MICHAEL SKOLNIK** is a professor emeritus in the department of leadership, higher and adult education at the University of Toronto, where previously he held the William G. Davis Chair in Community College Leadership, the first endowed chair in the study of higher education in Canada. His presentation will trace the development of Ontario's college system from predecessor institutions through the founding and evolution of the college sector over the past 50 years.
