All faculty (full-time, part-time, and partial load) are eligible to hold the fund. Up to three faculty may apply jointly to share a combined, larger fund for a collaborative project (to a maximum of \$4200). An individual faculty may only act as Principal Investigator on one TIF project at a time. The fund cannot support research that contributes directly to credentials.
