Dr. Christopher Stuart Taylor is an author, public servant, and assistant professor. He focuses on issues of diversity, inclusion, multiculturalism, immigration, race and ethnicity, anti-racism, Black Canadian history, Caribbean history, slavery in the Americas, the African and Black Diaspora, and Black identity. He has taught at Wilfrid Laurier University, Western University, and lectured internationally at such institutions as Harvard, Michigan State, the University of Wisconsin, and Saint Augustine University of Tanzania.

Dr. Taylor was the Diversity and Inclusion Coordinator in the Ministry of the Attorney General's Diversity, Inclusion & Accessibility Office. He is now a Senior Policy Advisor at Ontario's Anti-Racism Directorate.
