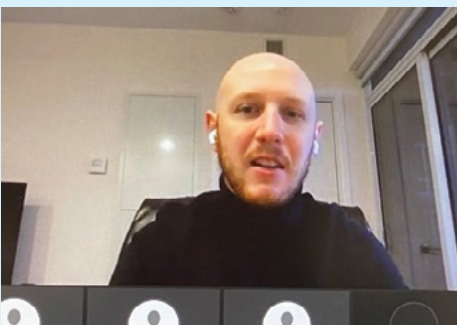


Paralegal Alumna Accepts Admission to Osgoode Hall Law School
