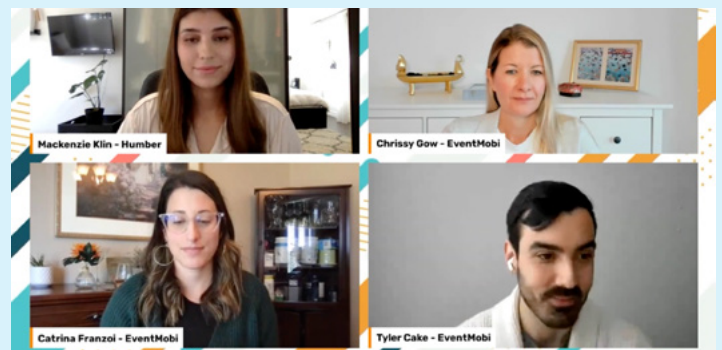

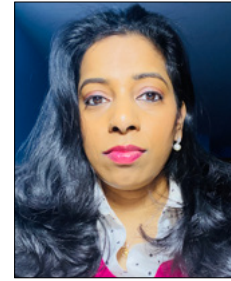

Fair, Consistent and Transparent - A Short Guide on Assessing Transfer Credits in Ontario

colleges, including Shawn Richards, Program Coordinator in the Faculty of Business at Humber.

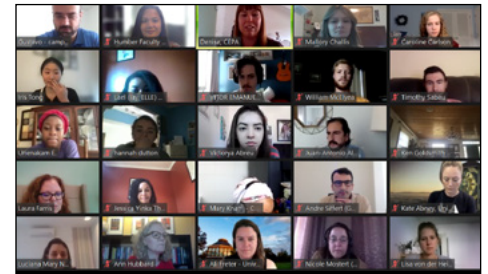
The new resource provides a starting point for faculty members, department chairs, and others who wish to ensure that their decision-making process is fair, consistent, and transparent.
