REGISTER FOR YOUR COURSE

Follow these four simple steps to secure your spot in the
Global Summer School! Registration opens on **April 1 - 2, 2019**

Step 1: Login

Login to **MyHumber**

Step 2: Select Course

- * Click **"Student"**
- * Click **"Registration"**
- * Select **"Register for Classes"**
- * Select the term **"Summer 2019"**
- * Under the **"Find Classes"** tab in the **"Course and Elective Attributes"** section, select **"Global Summer School"**
- * Select one of the available courses:
 - * **ECE 113:** Children, Play and Creativity
 - * **FMST 1000:** Designing Transmedia Interfaces
 - * **MEDC 1006:** Social Media
 - * **PROJ 300:** Socially Sustainable Development in Toronto
 - * **BUS 1000:** Systemic Design for Social Innovation
 - * **CDEV 2001:** Transformational Leadership and Advocacy

Step 3: Add Course to the Registration Area

- * Select one of the sections available, click **"Add"**
- * The selected course will move to the **Schedule and Summary** areas.
- * Check if there are any conflicts in the matrix
- * Click **"Submit"** to register

Step 4: Ensure Registration was Successful

- * Registration was processed when you clicked **"Submit"**
- * Ensure you see **"Registered"** status next to each course

Monday – Friday, from July 8 – 19, 2019 (MEDC 1006: Social Media) or July 8 – 26, 2019 (all other courses)
