It Takes All of Us

At the end of August, all Humber & University of Guelph-Humber students were enrolled in the It Takes All of Us module in Blackboard or CourseLink. It Takes All of Us is an asynchronous learning module that teaches participants about consent, sexual violence, bystander intervention, and supporting survivors of sexual violence.

Between August 25th and October 3rd...

1456
students
completed the
training.

932 students completed the exit survey. 159
students added
the training to
their CCR.

Prior to completing the training...

- 57% of respondents reported a lot or extensive knowledge of consent and sexual violence.
- 36% of respondents reported a lot or extensive knowledge of bystander intervention.

After completing the training...

- 95% of respondents reported a lot or extensive knowledge of consent and sexual violence.
- 92% of respondents reported a lot or extensive knowledge of bystander intervention.

Understanding Concepts

- 96% of respondents were able to choose the definition that best describes sexual violence from a list of three.
- 93% of respondents were able to choose definition that best describes consent from a list of three.

96% of respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they were satisfied with the training.

94% of respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they would recommend the training to others.
