BLACK HERITAGE MONTH

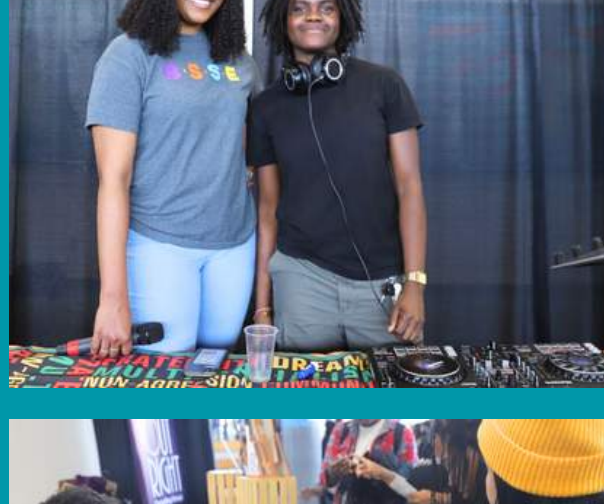
