## Review Library Links

Links from the following sources should be changed as soon as possible to ensure students have continuous access to the items:

- 1) Discover search platform: URL starts with "humber.summon.serialssolutions.com" or "tinyurl.com".
- 2) Library catalogue: URL starts with "humb.ent.sirsidynix.net".


Note: if the links are part of a Course Resources page created by the Library's copyright team, that team will update the links for you.
