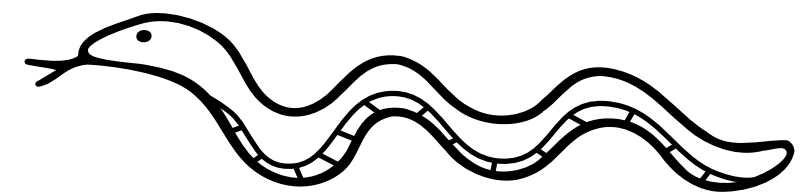

How can we keep at-risk communities safe from snakebites?

At least 600,000 people in tropical and sub-tropical countries are killed or maimed by snakebites every year. Unlike other diseases, treatment options exist for snakebite—but only if victims are able to access care.
