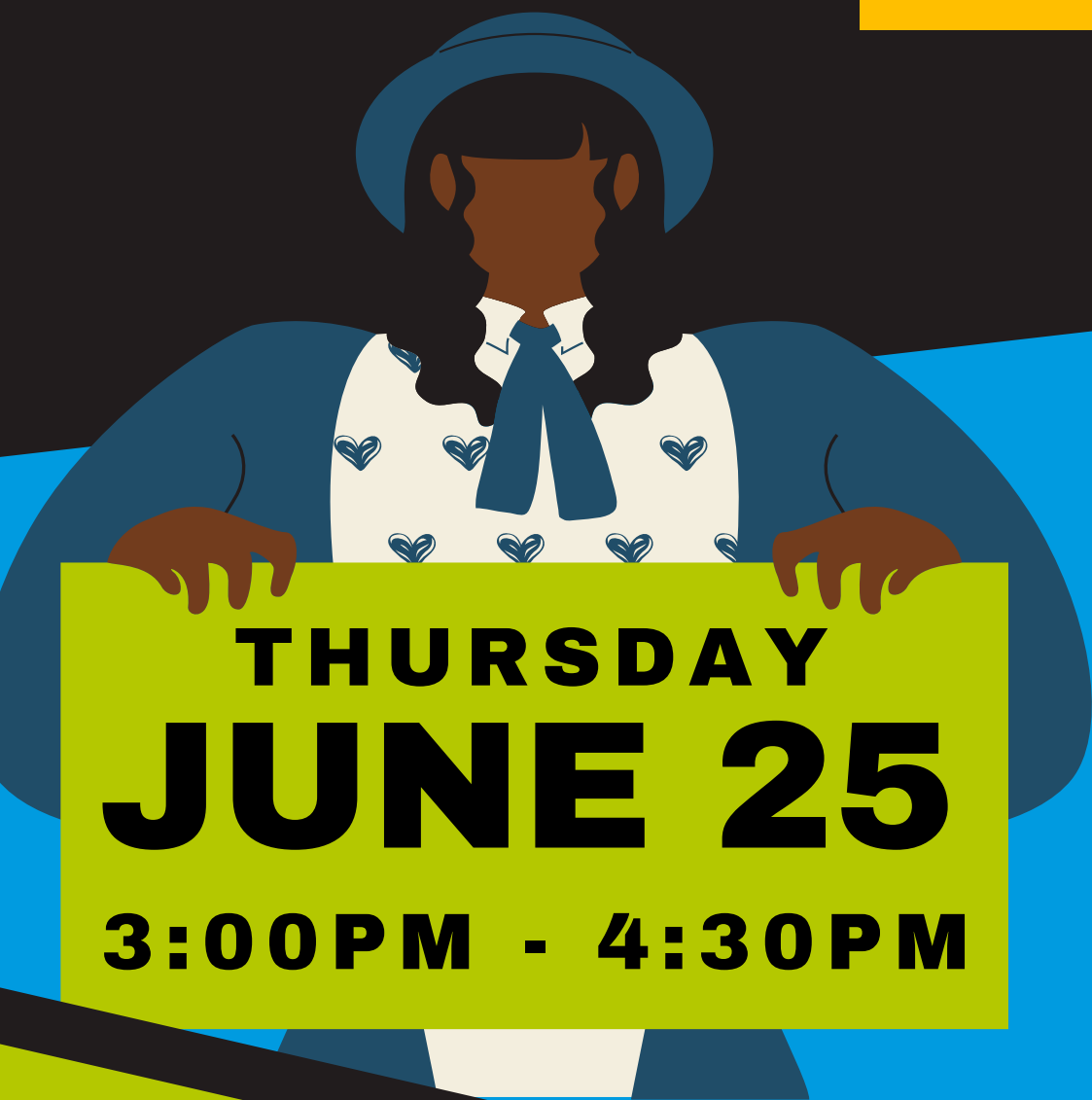

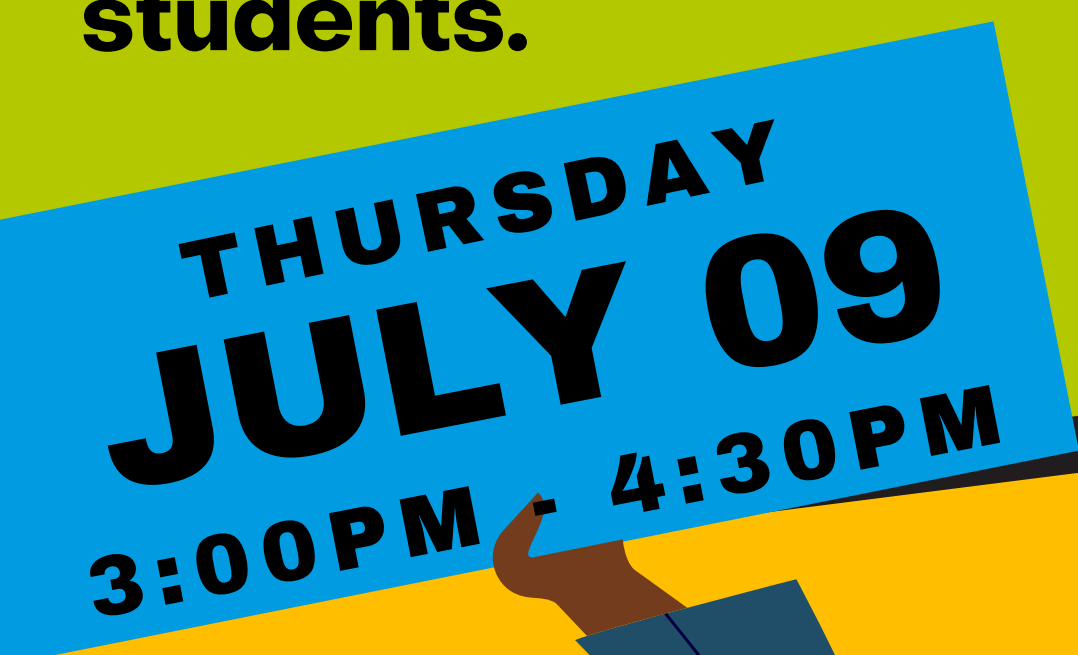
The BASE invites Humber and community members who identify within the Black community to engage in a dialogue that will help us unmask the trauma that historically has been and continues to be experienced by the Black community.
