
### Login

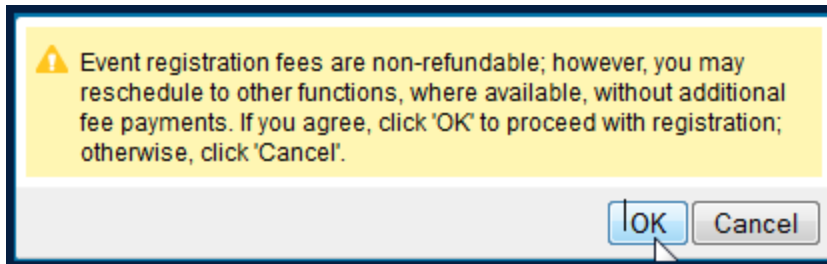


