Organics Recycling	<p>Does not require a bag but if they must be used, then it should be in clear or colour tinted bag and stored in the green 35 gallon totes provided by Wasteco.</p> <p>*Please do not include any soiled or contaminated paper.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Candies, cookies and cake Coffee grounds Dairy products and eggshells Fruit and vegetable scraps Meat, fish and bones Pasta, bread and cereal Coffee filters and tea bags (no other paper fibre)
Waste (With an Organics Program)	<p>Must be in clear or black bags and staged in its own material stream away from recyclables.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Black Plastics Coffee cups Paper towels and napkins Plastic and mylar bags Styrofoam & polystyrene cups and containers Personal Protection Gear
Waste (Without an Organics Program)	<p>Must be in clear or black bags and staged in its own material stream away from recyclables.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Black Plastics Coffee cups Food Waste Paper towels and napkins Plastic and mylar bags Styrofoam & polystyrene cups and containers Personal Protection Gear
Cardboard	<p>Can be loose, or in clear bags. Should be cleared of any contamination inside (packing material, foam, plastic jugs etc.). Any plastic film that may be wrapped around the cardboard must be removed.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Corrugated cardboard Boxboard Corner board Boxboard Tubes
