CO-CURRICULAR RECORD

The Co-Curricular Record (CCR) is a record of skill development outside of the classroom. It's a great addition to a job/internship application, scholarships/bursary requests, award nominations, and as an additional piece in your portfolio.

The average time commitment of the role is 6 hours a semester. To add the “Sustainability Ambassador” experience to your official CCR, you must complete the following requirements:

- Mandatory Training: Attend one onboarding training session at the start of the semester
- Events: Support or attend two sustainability events or Ambassador meetings
- Contribute to Sustainability Content: support filming two videos or write two posts for the blog



AMBASSADOR MEETINGS & TRAINING

Throughout the semester, the group comes together to hang out, discuss upcoming events, and learn together. Those meetings are not mandatory, although attendance is highly encouraged.
