ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Graduate from Humber with a two or three year Diploma
- Minimum cumulative average of "B"
- No grade less than "C"

COLLEGE ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

King's University College offers an unlimited number of CAAT Entrance Scholarships to qualified applicants. Students must remain registered in 4.0 courses and meet King's residency requirements. Averages and scholarship amounts are listed below.

Final Average	Scholarship Amount
80.0 - 81.9%	\$1000
82.0 - 84.9%	\$1500
85.0 - 89.9%	\$2000
90.0% or above	\$2500

Do I have to apply to a specific academic program at King's to be eligible to transfer my credits from Humber?

Students may apply to any program of interest at King's. Transfer credit is determined by your work at Humber, not the program that you apply to at King's. Regardless of program choice, applicants with a diploma may be eligible for a maximum of 5.0 transfer credits. Please find a full listing of King's programs below.

NEXT STEPS

1. Accept Your Offer

Once you have received an offer, please accept your offer through the OUAC by the deadline noted on your offer letter.

2. Meet your Admissions Conditions

If you are in progress in your Humber program and have received a conditional offer, you must meet the conditions listed in your offer.

3. Submit Your Final Transcript

Once you have completed your diploma, please forward your final Humber transcript to King's Enrolment Services. Once received, King's will finalize your transfer credit and scholarship eligibility.

4. Register For Your Academic Orientation

Once you have accepted your offer, follow the directions in your offer package to register for your Academic Orientation. During this orientation, an Academic Counsellor will help you understand how your transfer credit applies to your degree, help you choose your courses and learn about King's support services.
